Meet the Team

July- Lodge Picnic & Fireworks Party

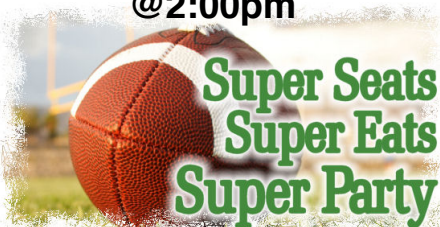
July- Old West BBQ & Chili Cook-Off
